What a truly special afternoon.

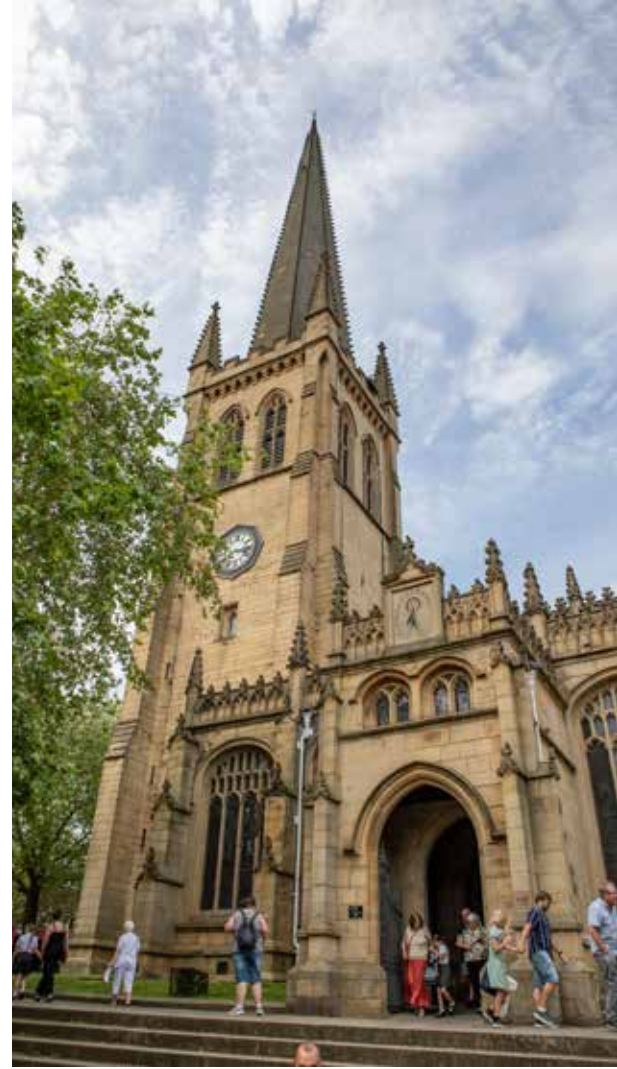

- **Smawthorne Henry Moore Academy**

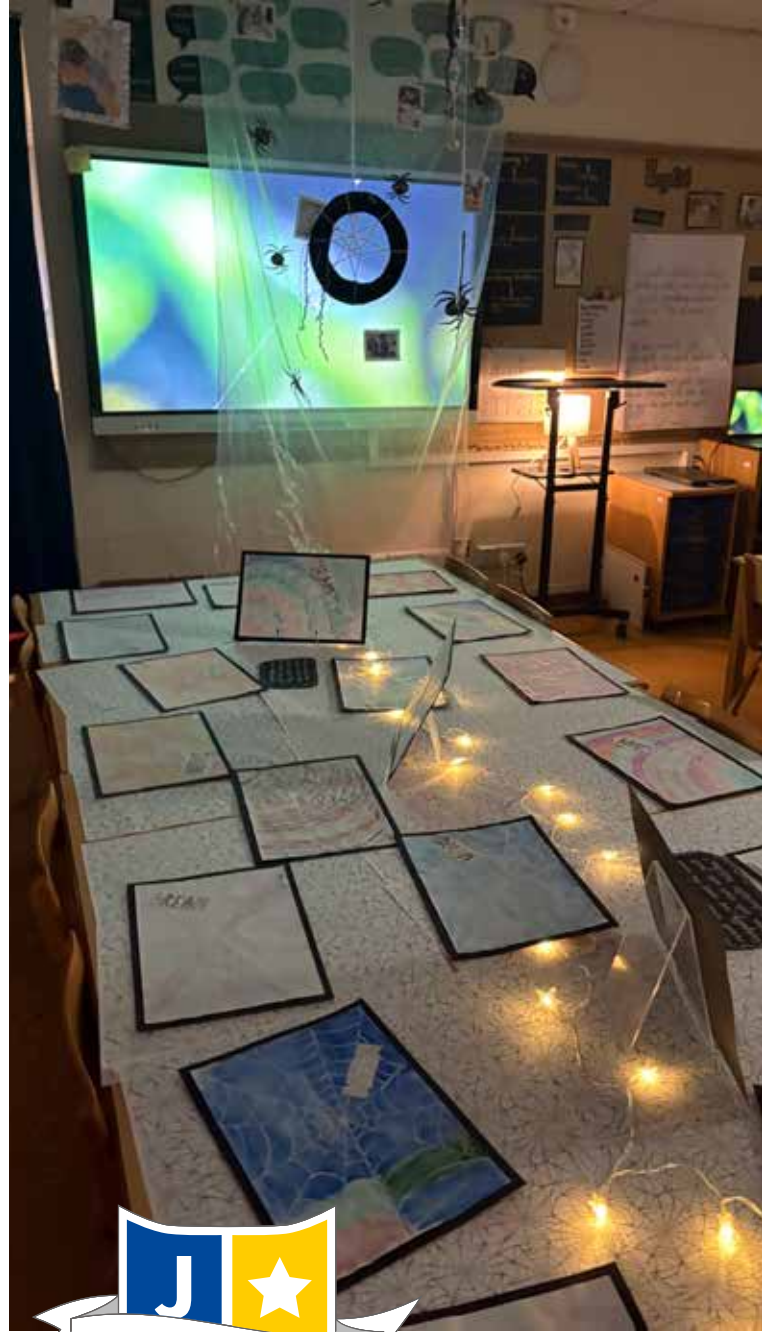
with Auckley Primary Academy and Townville Academy still to come.
